<b>Scheme Name</b>	<b>Rajarshi Chatrapati Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulka Pratipurti Yojana for Open, SEBC, EWS category student. (EBC)</b>
<b>Eligibility</b>	1) Student must be domicile of Maharashtra State. 2) Student should belong to categories viz. Open, SEBC, EWS 3) Admission through Centralized Admission Process conducted by Govt. of Maharashtra or its competent authority, Centralized Admission process of Institute.
<b>Income Limit</b>	1) Income should not be more than Rs. 8 lakhs in previous year at the time of admission. e.g. Student being admitted in academic year in July/August 2021, shall have Income certificate for financial year 2022-23 (01/04/2022 to 31/03/2023) certifying that income is less than Rs. 8 lakhs with declaration about validity of certificate is up to 31 <sup>st</sup> March 2024. 2) Income certificate must be issued by Tahasildar and should be in the name of father of the student only. In case, father is not alive, certificate should be in the name of mother supported by death certificate of father.
<b>Benefit (Reimbursement by Government)</b>	50% Tuition Fee and Exam Fee.
<b>Course covered</b>	Courses in DHE i.e. MSW, MCOM
<b>Renewal of Scheme</b>	Full pass or pass with ATKT
<b>Attendance</b>	75% attendance for each month in an academic year and required to appear each semester exam of both semester in an academic year.

<b>Scheme Name</b>	<b>Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Vasatigruha Nirvaha Bhatta Yojana for open category student.</b>
<b>Eligibility</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Student must be domicile of Maharashtra State.</li> <li>2) Student should belong to the categories viz. Open/SEBC/EWS/TFWS (Open)</li> <li>3) Admission through Centralized Admission Process conducted by Govt. of Maharashtra or its competent authority</li> <li>4) Candidates belonging to any of the categories but converted to OPEN category due to non-availability of any of the required certificates at the time of CAP and produces requisite certificate at a later stage after admission and fulfills criteria.</li> <li>5) Student should be hosteller.(College Hostel, Private Hostel, Paying Guest, Rented House) Local area resident students are not eligible for this scheme.</li> </ol>
<b>Income Limit</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Income should not be more than Rs. 8 lakhs in previous year at the time of admission. e.g. Student being admitted in academic year in July/August 2023, shall have Income certificate for financial year 2022-23 (01/04/2022 to 31/03/2023) certifying that income is less than Rs. 8 lakhs with declaration about validity of certificate is up to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024.</li> <li>2) Income certificate must be issued by Tahasildar and should be in the name of father of the student only. In case, father is not alive, certificate should be in the name of mother supported by death certificate of father.</li> </ol>
<b>Documents</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Student required to submits Small Land Holder certificate (अल्प-भू-धारक) or Register Labour (नोंदणीकृत शेतमजूर) Certificate of their parent.(Father Only. In case, father is not alive, certificate should be in the name of mother supported by death certificate of father.)</li> <li>2) If not submitting above documents then benefits are different.</li> </ol>
<b>Benefit (Reimbursement by Government)</b>	1) Rs. 2000/- for 10 months.
<b>Renewal of Scheme</b>	Full pass or pass with ATKT.
