- 3. Font: Times New Roman 12, 1.5 line spacing, 1 inch (2.5 cm) margin all sides.
- 4. To facilitate the blind review process, provide all author identity including acknowledgements. We treat it in confidence.
- 5. All full articles to be submitted for presentation must contain original research that has not been previously presented or scheduled for presentation or accepted, must not appear in print before the conference.
- 6. The research paper should not be more than 7000 words (excluding tables, figures and references)

The research paper should cover the following aspects:

a. Abstract & Keywords

b. Introduction

c. Brief literature review

- d. Methodology adopted
- e. The study hypothesis (if applicable) f. Empirical or theoretical results
- g. Inductive research if applicable h. Implications for theory and practice

 - 7. Case studies relevant to the International Conference theme are also accepted.

All papers submitted for publication will undergo the standard review process.


How to Reach CSIBER
