INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE SUMMARY

A three-day 'International Conference on Future Global Business and Technology (Challenges Ahead)' was inaugurated here today at the hands of Professor T. Mangaleswaran, Vice Chancellor of Vavuniya University of Sri Lanka and Professor (Dr) S. P. Rath, Director of the Chhatrapati Shahu Institute of Business Education and Research (CSIBER), Kolhapur. Dr. Ronald R. O'Donnell, Clinical Professor, Arizona State University, USA, Prof. Mangaleswaran, Dr. Mohamoud Yusuf Muse, President (Vice Chancellor), University of Hargeisa, Somali Land and Prof. Rath delivered the keynote speeches at the inaugural session. The speakers emphasized on adopting news technology and innovative management approaches by the business community to survive and excel in the post-Covid world.

Dr. O'Donnell participated online from the US and spoke on the topic 'Business Case — Social Workers in Integrated Healthcare: Return on Investment (RO) Strategies'. He said that the non-communicable diseases like blood pressure, heart problems, diabetes, depression and anxiety are on the rise in the post-Covid world. This has led to workplace absenteeism and decreased productivity of the businesses. The cost of healthcare has increased. The quality gap in healthcare services, excessive dependence on medication, wrong medication, side-effects of the medicines are aggravating the condition. Dr. O'Donnell emphasized that sciences like Ayurveda and Yoga from India can play a major role in achieving the goal of holistic intervention.

Prof. T. Mangaleswaran spoke on 'Global Business and Technology' and described the challenges faced by the global businesses in the post-Covid era and the changing environment due to rapid technological advancement. He mentioned about the changing organizational structure and suggested that the switching over from traditional to contemporary approach that is more dynamic, flexible, diverse, skill and team oriented can lead to high organizational performance. He said that the success of an organization depends on effective and efficient use of human and other resources. The goal should be to deliver high quality products and services to the customers at low cost.

Dr. Mohamoud Yusuf Muse talked about the shared bond between India and Somali Land and informed about the employment, business, trade and tourism opportunities in his country for Indians. He said that Indian teachers, students and NGOs are already tapping this potential which will only increase over the time.

Prof. (Dr) S. P. Rath spoke about the 'India-Sri Lanka Saga'. Marshaling effortlessly through extensive research data, he described how India and Sri Lanka shared common culture and heritage over past 2600 years. Giving various examples, he revealed how different dynasties from eastern and southern India exercised a greater influence in southeast Asia and drew a


clear distinction between India and the western imperial powers by underlining that Indian empires were not colonies but a second home to the traders.

Answering a question, Prof. Rath said that the India-China turf war being played on the soil of Sri Lanka is a temporary phase and is much hyped by the media. India and Sri Lanka will continue to live together in harmony like they have done for many centuries. Calling the bluff of the western dominated world order, he said that China could be a better friend of India than the US in future.

The debut meeting started with the lighting of conventional light by the dignitaries and melodic version of the 'Saraswati Vandana' by Prof. Sachin Jagtap. The new version of the 'South Asia Journal of Management Research' was delivered by the dignitaries at the event. The considerations on four subjects of the gathering viz. Management-Business and Commerce, Information Technology, Social Entrepreneurship and Environment — Man and Planet were held during the latter part of the day.

The dignitaries additionally visited different focuses of learning show to the gathering on the grounds and communicated with the staff and students. 

SPEAKERS SHARE EXPERIENCES ACROSS CONTINENTS

The 'International Conference on Future Global Business and Technology (Challenges Ahead)' being held at the Chhatrapati Shahu Institute of Business Education and Research (CSIBER), Kolhapur speakers opined that new technology has emerged as a major force multiplier for businesses the world over.

Dr. Terefe Zekele, Deputy CEO (EMI), Ethiopian Civil Service University. Addis Ababa, Dr. Pradipta Kadambari, Principal, Kadambari Memorial School of Social Work, Prubanchal University, Kathmandu, Nepal, Ms. Maria Morfidou, Head Social Worker from Greece and Dr. D. Dtta Roy of Indian Statistical Institute (ISI), Kolkata expressed their views through the hybrid mode.





Dr.Ronald R.O'Donnell Clinical Professor Arizona State University, USA

Dr. Terefe Zeleke spoke on the topic 'The Influence of Organisational Culture – Employees Commitment in Civil Services Organisations – The Cases of Selected Cities in Ethiopia'. He said that success of any organisation depends on committed employees which can be traced back to organisational culture. Organisations expect their employees to be well educated and experienced. However, a study in 2016 showed that most of the employees in Ethiopia were not satisfied with their jobs. Dr. Terefe Zeleke conducted research in this area with the use of modern technology and techniques and found out that level of employee commitment and job satisfaction was moderate

Dr. Pradipta Kadambari spoke about the correlation between the social workers and society. She said that the social workers should go beyond the NGOs and enter into social entrepreneurship and they should work with a multidisciplinary approach. She expected them to bring about ethicality and sustainability in the businesses and to adopt modern technology for attainment of the goals.

Ms. Maria Morfidou explained how Greece has gone through economic and ecological crises over the past few years. They mentioned that the social condition was further aggravated by the Covid pandemic and prolonged lockdowns. The plight of the persons with mental illnesses was especially bad. During this period modern technology came to the help of the citizens. In Greece, a public helpline was set up where people could call on specific telephone numbers for going out for groceries, medical aid, and meet people for specific purposes and to help out others. This helped them to cope up with the long and strict lockdowns.




