MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made between -

1. ALLEN CAREER INSTITUTE, having its Registered Office at CP-6, Sankalp, Indra Vihar, Kota (Raj.)
Represented by Shri Bharat Gupta (General Manager of Distance Learning Programme), hereinafter called the First Party.

AND

The Vasantryadada Patil Institute of Management Studies And Research, Address: NR. Bharti Hospital, Sangli-Miraj Road, Wanlesswadi Miraj. Represented By _____ Designation _____, hereinafter called the Second party.

2. That the First Party ALLEN Career Institute is imparting the Coaching for JEE (Main+ Advanced), JEE (Main), NEET-UG (Pre-Medical) and is also engaged in conducting the Periodic Tests (Popularly known as Test Series) for JEE(Main+Advanced) / JEE(Main) / NEET-UG (Pre-Medical) as per prescribed schedule at various locations in India.

The second party is a school/college / educational institute having all necessary infrastructure & resources that meet the first party's requirement to conduct the test series.

Both the signatories to the agreement are authorized statutorily to execute this agreement.

3. This MOU shall remain in force for one year from its signature & seal date. The agreement may be extended with the mutual consent of the parties from time to time. The parties to this MOU undertake to treat this agreement as "Confidential & Privileged".
4. Now, both the Parties have agreed to conduct the Test Series as per following Terms & Conditions:-

(A) Test Conduction Norms:

- (i) That the Tests (ASAT / Minor / Major) will be conducted at the premises of the Second Party as per schedule to be submitted by the First Party for the Academic Year 2022-23.
- (ii) That these Tests will be conducted on Sunday or Holidays during the period July 2022 to June 2023.
- (iii) That the Major Test Series will also be conducted from Dec 2022 to May / June 2023. The Schedule of Major Test Series will be provided in November/December 2022. These tests will also be conducted on Sunday/holidays and or other weekdays after the School hours considering the Time Table of Board Examinations.
- (iv) That the Test(s) will be conducted in the morning and afternoon shifts. The maximum duration of the Test will be 4.20 hours (2:00 / 3:00 / 3:20 / 4:00 hrs).
- (v) **COVID Guidelines:** The school is to ensure that COVID-19 Guidelines are complied strictly as per directives issued by Govt. Authorities from time to time.
- (vi) In case of cancellation of a test, pre-intimation of cancellation shall be given by both the parties and no payment shall be made for the cancelled test.
- (vii) Given any unforeseen circumstances, the liability regarding the tests and the students will have to be fulfilled by the second party. The first party will have no accountability here, whatsoever.

(B) The Second Party shall provide following Infrastructure facilities:

- (i) **Classroom(s)**
 - (a) That the Second Party will provide the Classroom(s) within its premises on the Test Date. Classrooms must be well equipped with comfortable furniture so that students can take their Test(s) comfortably.
 - (b) Each Classroom(s) must have proper lighting (tube Lights), Ceiling Fans, windows, cleanliness, etc. There should be an uninterrupted supply of electricity in the classroom during the Test Timings.
 - (c) Minimum 25 to 30 Tables and Chairs must be in one classroom to accommodate students comfortably. There should be a provision for separate washrooms for Boys & Girls.
- (ii) **Parking Space:**

The Second Party will ensure that-

 - (a) There should be an open space / shed where the students can park their vehicles safely.
 - (b) This parking space should be free of charge to the Students.
 - (c) Proper care & safety must be ensured for the vehicles.
- (iii) **Drinking Water:**

That the Second Party will ensure to provide pure drinking water to the students.

(C) The Second Party will provide following staff:

(i) Experienced invigilators to meet our Test norms as under:

- (a) There will be one invigilator on the strength of 25 to 30 students maintaining a minimum of one in each classroom.
- (b) Invigilator(s) will report half an hour before the scheduled time of Test Commencement to the Centre Coordinator and the representative of Allen Career Institute.
- (c) Invigilator(s) will be solely responsible for the distribution of Test Papers, Copies/OMR Sheets, and collections of the same. The invigilator will also be responsible for ensuring discipline in the classroom during the Test Time.
- (d) Invigilator(s) are required to coordinate with the representative of the First and Second Parties.
- (e) Requirement of No. of Invigilators (based on expected strength of students) will be informed in advance by ALLEN officials to the school coordinator.

(ii) Supporting Staff shall be responsible as under:

- (a) One Supporting Staff for every 100 students.
- (b) Seating arrangements as per norms laid down by the First Party.
- (c) To serve pure drinking water to the students during the Test.
- (d) General Cleanliness of the Class Room(s) & the Premises.
- (e) Parking arrangements for vehicles of the Students.
- (f) Distribution of Answer Key(s).

(iii) One senior person, known as the "Centre Coordinator" will be responsible as under:

- (a) Ensure that all the above resources are available well in time.
- (b) Coordinate with the First Party and its representatives on all subject matters about the Test Series.
- (c) Maintain and be accountable for all necessary records at the Test Centre as and when required by the First Party.
- (d) Collecting test papers and correctly filled answer sheets and submitting / sending (via courier) to Information Center, "Savitri" 89, Office No. 1, Industrial Estate, Near Udyog Bhawan, Latur (Maharashtra) – 413531.

(D) That the First Party will depute its authorized representative (s) at the Test Centre on each Test day who:

- (a) Will be responsible for the availability of Test Materials at the Centre.
- (b) Will coordinate overall activities of the Test(s) in association with the Centre Coordinator.
- (c) Will be the sole authority for making any instant decision at the Test Centre.

(E) Payments:

That the First Party will make Payments as under:

- (a) **Infrastructure:**
Minimum Payment of Rs 1000/- per day up to 200/- students.
- (b) **Invigilation Charges:**
Pay to each Invigilator Rs. 400/- per test.
- (c) **Supporting Staff:**
Pay to each Supporting Staff Rs. 200/- per test.
- (d) **Centre Coordinator:**
Pay to Centre Coordinator Rs. 500/- per test.

All above payments must be acknowledged by the official receipts on the same day. The Center Coordinator and ALLEN Career Institute representative both will ensure compliance.

Both the Parties undertake to fulfil all responsibilities on their Part which may be altered or modified based on the need with mutual consent.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets for the terms and understanding between 'The Parties', for organising programmes for the community.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (herein after called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 25th day of March 2022 by and between

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY



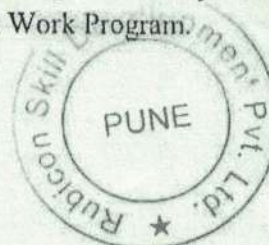


4.9. Termination:

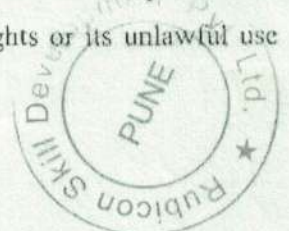
9. Notices:




