




The Changing Climate: Evidence, Impacts, and Future Pathways




Library Day at CSIBER: Upholding Dr. S.R. Ranganathan's Vision for Education and Information Accessibility

The International Conference on 'Transforming the Future: Innovations in Management, Technology, Social Impact and Environmental Stewardship' **19th and 20th September 2025**

The conference has commenced with a warm welcome address by Dr. B. N. Menon, I/C Director, CSIBER. In her address, she introduced the theme and four dimensions of the conference, highlighted the significance of AI, block chain, and quantum computing alongside corporate governance, ethics, and social justice, while appreciating the diversity of participants. The first key note speaker of the day Mr. Rathod (MD Caspro International) in his keynote speech has emphasized innovation as a driver of sustainability, drawing insights from Japan's civic culture, Caspro's carbon neutrality vision for 2030, and his company's eco-sensitive and community-driven initiatives. His message "Future is something we create" deeply resonated with the audience.

Prof. Ananthini Nandkumaran (Vovuniya University, SriLanka) has delivered on significance of revitalizing traditional water management systems, particularly Sri Lanka's Village Tank Cascade System, demonstrating how ancient wisdom when integrated with the modern science, can address water security and climate resilience. After Professor Ananthini, Dr. Ramma provided an evidence-based presentation on Determinants of Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) in Mauritius, highlighting prenatal, and environmental risk factors, while calling for greater awareness and early interventions.
