## Eco-Friendly Ganesha Idol Making Workshop

### Introduction

V.P institute of Management Studies & Research, Sangli recently organized an eco-friendly Ganesha idol making workshop together with Appasaheb Birnale Architecture College, Sangli. This was a great initiative taken by our college's social outreach cell for students and teachers. This workshop brought every participant's inner artist and helped them make their own Ganesha idol. It's a great feeling to design and create a Ganesh idol of our own. It creates a special bond between participants and their idol.

As part of V.P.I.M.S.R's commitment to environmental sustainability and cultural preservation, this initiative aimed to promote awareness about the harmful effects of traditional idol making practices on water bodies and encourage the adoption of eco-friendly alternatives.

The program began with an expert demonstration by experienced artisans who showcased the techniques of creating Ganesha idols using natural, biodegradable materials.

Experts also delivered a small speech on the environmental impact of traditional idol making practices, highlighting the pollution caused by the immersion of chemically-treated idols in water bodies. The importance of using eco-friendly materials and proper disposal methods was emphasized. Inspired by hearing it some more students joined the workshop and contributed towards better environment.

Participants divided themselves into groups as per their registration and were provided with the necessary materials, including clay, paints, and natural pigments. They were guided by the experts to create their own unique Ganesha idols.

The program was a great success, with enthusiastic participation from students, faculty, and staff. Total 61 students from different classes (BBA II, BCA II, BBA III, BCA III, DIT, M.COM I, MBA II, MCA II 'B') participated in the Workshop along with 2 Faculty members. The eco-friendly idols created during the program were distributed to the participants, who pledged to immerse them in a sustainable manner.

All the above mentioned industries were visited by the students. The nature of these industries was different like some were manufacturing unit, IT and Technology, Services Delivery and many other sectors.

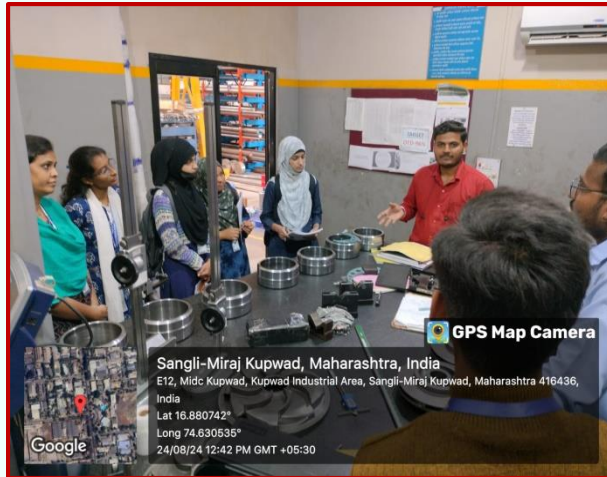
